Will China go the old Soviet way of burying socialism from a realistic perspective? In the 14th People's Congress just past, the CPC amended the Constitution once again to change the original "legislation shall follow the basic principles of the Constitution" to "legislation shall adhere to the leadership of the Communist Party of China", something that can be different from the ideal and realism. But in terms of historical cycles, this is another proof of a regime's collapse.

What does this mean? It means that the Republic is no longer a state of law, but a party state, where everything is done in the interest of the party, and no longer pursued by the rule of law, and justice. The People's Republic of China is literally a republic of the Chinese people, whose core interests are for the people. This concept was implemented in the early years of the country when the pot-luck era was achieved, and now after the law was changed the revisionist government is transforming China step by step into a developed feudal-imperialist state, re-enslaving the people to make them pets of vested interests. In today's China, the proportion of workers' and peasants' representatives in the National People's Congress is also getting lower and lower, from 51.6% in 1975 to 12.5% in the recent 19th Congress today. The Congress is becoming less and less representative of the people and is gradually turning China's centralized democracy into a joke.

The next step after the amendment of the law is to strengthen the control and weaken the people's enthusiasm for the rule of law and political participation, and to continue to brainwash the people into livestock that only run for their daily livelihoods, leading the country is to destruction under the illusory high GDP growth rate. This means that the social structure is becoming more and more pyramidal rather than an olive social structure that society have a large number of middle class and a small number of extremely rich and extremely poor families. The dividends of development never reach the people except for the small elite. The people have been excluded from the political game for a long time, and in today's China, the people have come to believe that politics is irrelevant to them and have begun to acquiesce to the rights of interest groups to oppress them.

Recently, the novel "Kong Yiji" by Lu Xun in the Republic of China was once again hotly debated by Chinese netizens. It started when the official media, People's Daily, published an article asking people with higher education to put down their dignity and become workers on the assembly line. People started a heated discussion, angry that they had studied hard for more than ten years to become the cheap labor of the new generation and that the wrong policy had ruined their lives. They started to quote the excerpts from Engels' "The Condition of the Working Class in England" and criticized the current ruling party in China for its incompetence and for deliberately maintaining a high level of competition that has led to extreme oppression of the working class. The times need me to be a student and a peasant, I see it as a puppet, a test case"

As a citizen of the People's Republic of China, I suggest that after recognizing the reality of the situation, we should first unite the left-wing proletarians who are conscious of the situation, and then gradually influence the working class who are numb to life, with the ultimate goal of violently overthrowing the existing revisionist government and uniting all the forces that can be united at this stage in order to achieve the program.

The countless repetitions of history have repeatedly proved that any power group that stands in opposition to the people will be overthrown by the people, and this is the most powerful force that the proletariat at large possesses. The unity that will usher in victory is

limited by the class attributes of the proletariat, but only after unity can we re-establish a republic that truly serves the people and can truly work for the arrival of a social and even communist society.
